---- ASSISI----



It is the city of the Saints, San Francesco and Santa Chiara, and is the symbol of a message of peace to be breathed at every step along its beautiful streets. Assisi is an Umbrian jewel in the province of Perugia which lies delicately on the slopes of Mount Subasio.

HISTORICAL NOTES: The life of medieval Assisi was very eventful: it became the object of continuous conquests and sieges, triggered by the dispute between the Germanic and Byzantine peoples. A period that led to the construction of many of the castles, including the Rocca Maggiore. As an independent municipality, Assisi experienced a moment of great splendor thanks to the monastic movements, in particular that of the Benedictines. In 1182, Saint Francis of Assisi was born there, a man who was a symbol of the city because he put himself at the service of God by helping the poor, stripping himself of his family's wealth. His figure was associated with that of Saint Clare of Assisi, spiritual pupil of Saint Francis and founder of the order of the Poor Clares: at 18 she fled from her rich family to join Francis at the small church of Santa Maria degli Angeli.

TO VISIT: You can start from the Papal Basilica of San Francesco and Sacro Convento: composed of two overlapping churches, the upper and lower Basilica, where there is a crypt in which the tomb of the Saint is located. An important chapter of Italian art was written here: the works of Giotto, Cimabue, Simone Martini and Pietro Lorenzetti can be found here. The next stop is the Basilica of Santa Chiara, built immediately after her death. In full Umbrian Gothic style, it preserves important relics of such Saint and Saint Francis. Continue to the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, built to protect some of the important places in the life of Saint Francis: inside there is the small church in which he composed the Canticle of the Creatures and where he died. Last stop is the Rocca Maggiore, the imposing bastion that dominates the city and the nearby countryside. And it doesn't end here: Assisi is full of surprises, all of them beautiful. A visit to the Temple of Minerva is also highly recommended. Transformed into the church of Santa Maria above Minerva at the behest of Pope Paul III in 1539, it represents the most intact Roman building in the entire region. San Damiano, on the other hand, is a sanctuary with a special soul. Today it is the seat of a Franciscan novitiate for those young people who, eager to follow Jesus on the path of Francis of Assisi, are experiencing "the year of trial". If you still have time, visit the Domus del Larario of Assisi, an ancient and prestigious Roman residence from the first century AD, discovered by chance only in 2001.

--- HOW TO REACH ASSISI----

BY CAR

From South: For those arriving from the south, the best exit from the A1 motorway is Orte. Continue towards Perugia from the SS204 (direction Terni) first, and then the E45 (or SS3bis) from Terni to Perugia. Before Perugia, at Ponte San Giovanni, follow the signs for Assisi, taking the E45, close to Collestrada on the SS75, exit at Santa Maria degli Angeli and follow the signs for Assisi.

From North: Coming from the north on the A14 on the Adriatic coast, to get to Assisi the exit is Cesena, then continue on the E45 up to Citta' di Castello, then arriving at the Collestrada crossroads leave the E45 to take the SS75. Exit at Santa Maria degli Angeli and follow the signs to reach Assisi. Arriving in Assisi from the A1 motorway, exit at Valdichiana, continue on the SS75bis which overlooks Lake Trasimeno in Umbria, first, and then to Perugia. Arriving at Ponte San Giovanni, proceed towards Assisi, close to Collestrada on the SS75, exiting at Santa Maria degli Angeli and then following the signs for Assisi.

BY TRAIN

From South: To get to Assisi by train from the south, on the main line between Rome and Ancona the station is Foligno (on the Spello, Assisi, Perugia and Lake Transimeno branch). Coming from Rome, take one of the daily trains on the Ancona line, stop in Foligno, and then change and take a train towards Perugia (10 to 15 min.). All the above trains stop in the Santa Maria degli Angeli station, 3 km away from the historic center. A bus service departing from the square in front of the station will allow you to reach the city centre.

From North: Arriving in Assisi from the north, via the main line between Florence and Rome, the station is Terontola (on the Lake Trasimeno, Perugia, Assisi, Spello and Foligno branch). Coming from Florence it is necessary to take one of the daily trains to Terontola / Cortona (90 min.), and the connection with a train to Assisi / S.Maria degli Angeli (45 to 60 min.).

AIRPORTS

The closest major airports to Assisi are in Rome and Florence, and it is easily accessible from these two cities by train, bus or car. The main international gateway is Rome Leonardo da Vinci Airport, known as Fiumicino. Florence A. Vespucci airport is known as Peretola. The recommended solution to get to Assisi by plane is to land in Rome and continue to Assisi by bus or train.
